Navsarjan organized a kidney disease awareness camp to educate the community about kidney health, which took place in Batliboy and Ganeshnagar. A total of 68 participants, both women and men, attended the camp, where they learned about kidney diseases, their symptoms, and preventive measures. The primary goal was to raise awareness and teach attendees how to identify symptoms related to kidney health.

At the conclusion of the camp, participants received free blood sugar and blood pressure tests. This initiative significantly increased awareness of kidney diseases among attendees, many of whom opted for the health screenings. During the tests, 2 individuals were found to have high blood pressure, while 3 women exhibited elevated blood sugar levels. They were advised to consult a doctor for appropriate treatment and management.

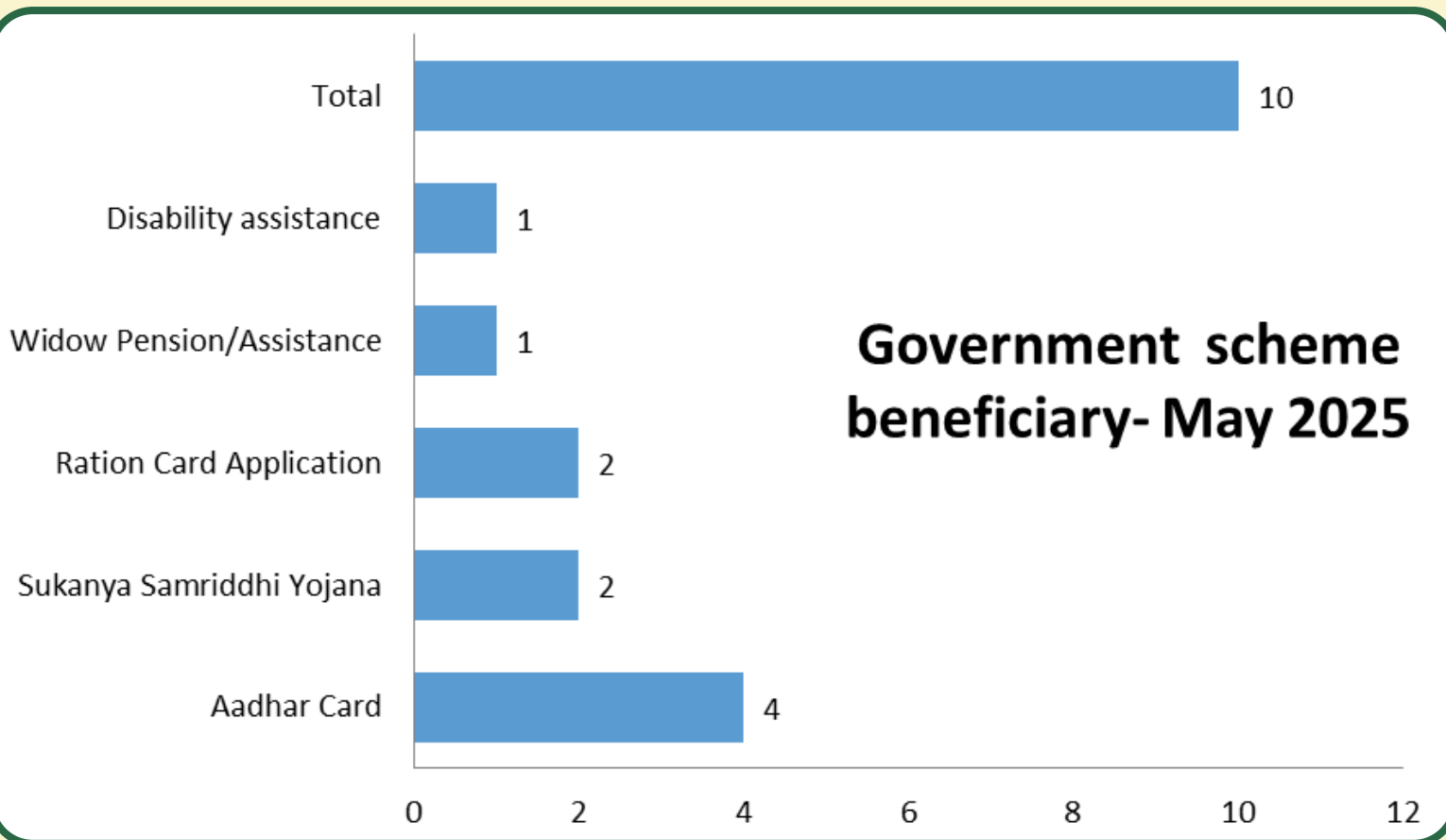


Bhagyalakshmi Credit Co-Operative Society Ltd.
